Intro to Video Production

Each year KMVT 15 offers 14 weeks of camps for students ages 10-14. Our one-week Intro to Video Production Camp introduces youths to a hands-on media production experience in a studio environment. Students use KMVT 15's professional studio equipment to gain basic skills in camera work, directing, audio, acting and producing. By the end of the week, students produce segments including Game Shows, Talk Shows and Entertainment performances which will broadcast on cable Channel 15! Each student receives a DVD copy of the program they produce. The TV station provides all equipment. (Bring a sack lunch & drink!)
